Educational & Professional Background

Razvan Margauan holds an MSc in Aerospace Engineering from University Politehnica of Bucharest (1993) and a degree in International Business from the Academy of Economic Studies in Bucharest (1997). He began his career at ROMATSA as an ATS Expert and Head of the ATS Development Division. In 1999, he joined EUROCONTROL, where he has since held various leadership roles, including Head of ATM-CNS Strategy and Program Manager for the Centralised Services Programme Management Office.

Key Achievements or Career Highlights

One of his primary career milestones was his instrumental role in developing Romania's first Air Traffic Control (ATC) simulator during his time at ROMATSA. He is a Project Management Professional (PMP) certified expert and holds an Air Traffic Controller License for Area Control. Beyond his corporate duties, he is a founding member of the AirNav Board, a prestigious Think Tank of Romanian aerospace graduates. Through this group, he was key in delivering a modern, pragmatic curriculum for the 'Air Navigation - Air Transport Engineering' study programs initiated at his alma mater in 2009.
